Ottawa, February 12, 2018 – This year marks the fourth edition of the Ottawa Winter Brewfest, coming up February 16 and 17 in the Aberdeen Pavilion at Lansdowne Park. The festival's three sessions have lots of exciting discoveries in store for beer lovers.

More breweries, more beers

True to form, the Ottawa Winter Brewfest will showcase even more beers from Quebec and Ontario—five times more breweries, in fact, than last year. Étienne Brûlé, Flora Hall, Haliburton, Whiskeyjack, Oast House and Vimy are just a few of the two dozen or so breweries that will be sharing their love of their craft at this year's event, alongside another twenty whose products will be available at the main bars.

A new, larger venue

Given the popularity of the festival's first three editions, the Winter Brewfest has moved to a venue that can accommodate more exhibitors and visitors. The Aberdeen Pavilion offers an outdoor section where festivalgoers can enjoy a bonfire and maple taffy on snow, and an indoor VIP section with a rest area.
